DUPAGE COUNTY TRAFFIC COURTS TO
REMAIN CLOSED THROUGH JANUARY 15TH
DUE TO COVID-19

DuPage County Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin announced today that due to the ongoing and significant increase in COVID-19 cases throughout the State of Illinois and DuPage County, he has issued an Administrative Order directing that all matters scheduled for traffic court on or between January 4th, 2021 and January 15th, 2021 be rescheduled to a future court date by the Circuit Court Clerk. These matters will be reset to a future court date at least 28 days from their current court date. The rescheduled dates can be viewed by attorneys at eaccess.18thjudicial.org (eaccess) and the general public at epay.18thjudicial.org (epay). The Clerk will also send notice via mail to all interested parties.

As a result of rescheduling these matters, all traffic courts will remain closed through January 15th, 2021. “In order to protect the health and safety of court employees and the general public, we decided that keeping the traffic courts closed through January 15th was the responsible and prudent step to take in response to the continued increase in COVID-19 cases. We will continue to closely monitor the situation and follow the guidance provided by the CDC, IDPH and DuPage County Health Department.” said Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin.
