Certain money, like social security, is already protected. The wildcard exemption protects personal property that is not otherwise protected, like employment income or money you got as a gift.



When you file your *Motion*, ask the Circuit Clerk if you have to schedule a court date or if one will be scheduled automatically. In some counties, you may get the court date when you e-file. Include the court date on your *Notice*.
