In re: Closure of the Supreme Court of Illinois Facilities

ORDER

On the basis of current, active weather alerts by the National Weather Service that are reliably predicting significant and problematic snow accumulation, wind speeds causing blizzard conditions, and extremely low air temperatures and wind chills in Cook County on Friday, December 23, 2022; it appearing that said conditions would significantly threaten the safety and welfare of judges, court system employees, and persons having business with the court; and to ensure that no one is placed in a position of harm in traveling to and from court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Illinois Courts facilities in the Michael A. Bilandic Building in Chicago, the Supreme Court Building in Springfield, and the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts offices in both Chicago and Springfield will be closed beginning Thursday, December 22, 2022 at 12:00 p.m. and continuing on Friday, December 23, 2022.
