In re: Appellate Court Administrative Committee of the Supreme Court

Order

Effective immediately, the charge, membership, and duties of the Appellate Court Administrative Committee of the Supreme Court is set forth as follows:

- (1) Charge. The Supreme Court has established the Appellate Court Administrative Committee to study and recommend methods by which the Appellate Court might improve the processing of appeals.
- (2) Membership. The Supreme Court shall appoint seven members of the Committee. The membership shall consist of one justice from the Second, Third, Fourth, and Fifth Districts and three justices from the First District of the Appellate Court.
- (3) Chair of the Committee. The members of the Committee shall elect a chair from its membership.
- (4) Duties of the Committee. In realizing the charge of the Committee, the duties of the Committee shall include:
 - a. conducting regular meetings to carry out the Committee's business;
 - b. studying and recommending rule or practice changes that enhance the procedures of the Appellate Court;
 - c. communicating with the Supreme Court and the districts of the Appellate Court relating to issues of concern;
 - d. planning and developing educational programs, including for the Appellate Court Education Conference and the Joint Appellate Court Conference in collaboration with the Illinois Judicial College and the Judicial College Division of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts; and
 - e. setting the agenda for the annual business meetings of the Appellate Court.
- (5) Staff. Members of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts shall staff the Committee.
