The Order of October 1, 1999, amended on October 4, 1999 and September 25, 2003, is further amended as follows, effective immediately:

RESIGNATION PROCEDURE FOR JUDGES

A resignation from the office of judge shall be in writing to the Chief Justice of the Illinois Supreme Court with copies provided to <u>persons specified below as applicable</u>. The resignation shall state in writing the effective date and time of the resignation and that copies were provided to the relevant required persons. the Justice(s) over the district in which the resignation occurs and the Director of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts. In the case of an appellate court judge, a copy of the resignation shall also be submitted to the Presiding Justice. In the case of a circuit judge or an associate judge, a copy of the resignation shall also be submitted to the Chief Circuit Judge.

In the case of a circuit judge or associate judge, a copy of the resignation to the Chief Justice shall be submitted to the following persons:

- 1. The Supreme Court Justice(s) representing the district in which the resignation occurs;
- 2. The Director of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts; and
- 3. The Chief Circuit Judge of the judicial circuit in which the resignation occurs.

In the case of an appellate court judge, a copy of the resignation to the Chief Justice shall be submitted to the following persons:

- 1. The Supreme Court Justice(s) representing the district in which the resignation occurs;
- 2. The Director of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts; and
- 3. <u>The Presiding Appellate Court Judge of the appellate court district in which the resignation occurs.</u>
