## <u>AMENDED</u> ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-3 <u>TEMPORARY ORDER RE: JURY TRIALS</u>

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court's order of May 20, 2020, in M.R. 303070, implicitly allows circuits to step back from their reopening plans as dictated by local conditions;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, effective immediately, the following procedures are in effect in the 21st Judicial Circuit:

- 1. <u>Civil Jury Trials</u>. It is hereby ordered that all Circuit and Associate Judges in the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit are authorized to continue civil trials. There will be no civil jury trials until February 14, 2022, at the earliest.
- 2. <u>Criminal Jury Trials</u>. It is hereby ordered that all Circuit and Associate Judges in the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit <u>will be continuing</u> all criminal jury trials for all defendants who are not currently in custody or whose cases do not involve speedy trial demand until February 14, 2022 or after.
