TEMPORARY ORDER RE: JURY TRIALS


WHEREAS, the Supreme Court's order of May 20, 2020, in M.R. 303070, implicitly allows circuits to step back from their reopening plans as dictated by local conditions;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, effective immediately, the following procedures are in effect in the 21st Judicial Circuit:

1. **Civil Jury Trials**. It is hereby ordered that all Circuit and Associate Judges in the 21st Judicial Circuit are authorized to continue civil trials. There will be no civil jury trials until February 14, 2022, at the earliest.

2. **Criminal Jury Trials**. It is hereby ordered that all Circuit and Associate Judges in the 21st Judicial Circuit *will be continuing* all criminal jury trials for all defendants who are not currently in custody or whose cases do not involve speedy trial demand until February 14, 2022 or after.
