Minor Guardianship Publication Information for Newspaper

Instructions to Guardian:

- If you need to publish notice of this case, you can deliver this form to the newspaper.
- There is a fee to publish. If you cannot afford the fee, you can file for an Application for Waiver of Court Fees. In some counties, once you have been granted a fee waiver, you may also have to ask the judge to sign an order that the county pay the cost of publication. In other counties, you can just provide the newspaper with a copy of your fee waiver order they will publish your notice without charge to you.
- Do not file this form with the court. (In some counties, the Circuit Clerk will send the case information to the newspaper. Ask the Circuit Clerk about the process in your county.)
- The newspaper must print the notice at least once a week for three weeks in a row. A Certificate of Publication from the newspaper showing what they published and when has to be filed with the Clerk. Ask the newspaper if they send the Certificate directly to the Clerk. If they do not, you will need to file the Certificate with the Clerk.
