In the exercise of this Court's supervisory authority, the Appellate Court, Fourth District, is directed to vacate its judgment in People v. Jeanpierre, case No. 4-24-0462 (06/11/24). The appellate court is directed to consider the effect of this Court's opinion in People v. Cousins, 2025 IL 130866, on the issue of whether, upon remand to the circuit court, the circuit court should conduct a new hearing on the State's petition to deny pretrial release or conduct a hearing on the conditions of release, and determine if a different result is warranted.
