

ADDITIONAL STATEMENT OF FACTS
 [Refer to Illinois Supreme Court Rule [341\(h\)\(6\)](#)]

Continue to tell the story of what happened in the trial court, with reference to the specific pages of the record where each fact appears. Refer to pages of the common law record as "C [page]." Refer to pages of the report of proceedings as "R [page]." For example, "On January 2, 2015, the plaintiff filed his complaint. C 1." Then say what happened before the appellate court.

If you included pages from the record in your appendix, refer to both the record page **and** appendix page where the information appears. For example, "C [page]; A [page]."

You should describe the following:

- what was said in the complaint or petition,
- anything relevant that happened in court before the trial,
- the testimony of all witnesses,
- how the judge ruled, any findings by the jury, and anything that happened in court after the trial, and what happened in the appellate court and how the appellate court ruled.

Refer to the specific pages of the record on appeal where each fact appears.

Tell the story accurately and fairly. Do not make arguments or comments here
