**TEMPORARY PROCEDURES FOR
CIVIL DIVISION MATTERS IN SMALL CLAIMS**)
)

WHEREAS, due to COVID and the high volume nature of Courtroom 120, a backlog of cases in Courtroom 120 has developed; and

WHEREAS, to move cases through Courtroom 120 more efficiently, some cases will need to be temporarily re-assigned; and

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Civil Division and the Chief Judge of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit have determined that re-assigned cases will be heard in Courtroom 240,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective October 5, 2021 through December 7, 2021 the following temporary procedures will apply to small claims cases:

- 1) Cases re-assigned to Courtroom 240 will be by Court Order or at the attorneys request to have it scheduled in Courtroom 240 with proper notice.
- 2) Cases will be limited to 125 for status and routine matters and 15 for motions in the morning and limited to 60 cases in the afternoon.
- 3) Court will be conducted in-person and remotely via Zoom. The Zoom link is located on the 16th Judicial Circuit's website under Courtroom 240.


