Per curiam

In this case, Jimmie Marshall pleaded guilty to aggravated battery, was sentenced to probation, and was released from custody. This rendered moot Marshall's earlier challenge to his pretrial detention for the offense, meaning the court could no longer grant him effective relief. Defendant argued the case should still be addressed under the public interest exception, but the supreme court found the law on waiver of claims under Rule 604(h) to be not presently in disarray or evading review. The supreme court dismissed the appeal and vacated the decisions below.
