
SUPREME COURT OF ILLINOIS NUMBER OF CASES DECIDED WITH FULL OPINIONS 1950-196 8




SUPREME COURT OF ILLINOIS NUMBER OF PETITIONS FOR REHEARING 1950-1968



To the Judges of the Circuit Court of Cook County:

Attached is the Statistical Bulletin for calendar year 1968.

In 1968, the total inventory of pending law cases decreased in both the Law Division and in the Municipal Department. In all other types of cases the inventory of pending cases increased. Specifically, the results were as follows:

LAW JURY CASES OVER \$10,000

In 1968, the inventory of pending law jury cases decreased. The inventory reduction occurred this year despite the fact there were fewer terminations than last year, fewer trial judges than last year and fewer verdicts than during any of the past four years. Factors which contributed to the inventory reduction include the terminations achieved during the summer trial and pre-trial programs as well as the decrease in new cases filed. While it should be noted that the reduction in the number of cases begun in recent years has reduced the total inventory of pending cases, that reduction has no effect on the number of older cases waiting to be heard. All of these factors must be considered in analyzing the decreased inventory:

1. The number of new cases begun in the County Department, Law Division has decreased. The following chart shows the number of cases begun (new filings plus cases transferred) for each calendar year since 1964:

In terms of "acceptable inventory" and "backlog" as of the end of 1968, 21704 or 50.8% of the pending law jury cases are acceptable inventory (not over two years old) and 21057 or 49.2% are backlog inventory (over two years old).

LAW JURY CASES \$10,000 AND UNDER MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENT

The delay in the trial of law jury cases in the suburban districts of the Municipal Department continues to be very low. Though the delay in District 1 (City of Chicago) is quite high (56.4 months) the percentage of backlog inventory is relatively low:

With the Clerk's help, we have reviewed all filings, transfers and reinstatements in the Law Division, County Department for the years 1962 through 1968. The Chart on the next page (page 5) showing Age of Pending Law Cases has been revised so that the figure titled "Total Filed" for Law Jury Cases over \$10,000 now reflects only cases newly filed or transferred during each such year. In previous reports "Total Filed" figure included cases reinstated during each year, as well as those newly filed or transferred during each year. The old reporting system made it appear that more cases were filed each year than actually were. A reinstated case was being counted more than once (viz., once when it was filed and once each time it was reinstated).


