2. GRANTED – PARTIAL WAIVER
The Application for Waiver of Criminal Court Assessments is granted, effective on the date the Application was first filed. The court finds (check one):
<b>75%</b> of all assessments are waived. The applicant <b>must pay 25%</b> of all assessments because the applicant's available income is more than 200% but not greater than 250% of the current poverty level; or
<b>50%</b> of all assessments are waived. The applicant <b>must pay 50%</b> of all assessments because the applicant's available income is more than 250% but not greater than 300% of the current poverty level; or
<b>25%</b> of all assessments are waived. The applicant <b>must pay 75%</b> of all assessments because the applicant's available income is more than 300% but not greater than 400% of the current poverty level.
Income findings are based on the current poverty level as established by the U.S. Dept. of Health & Human Services, and the applicant's non-exempt assets under $\frac{735 \text{ ILCS } 5/12-901}{1001}$ and $\frac{735 \text{ ILCS } 5/12-1001}{1001}$ are such that the applicant is unable to pay the assessments.
