Order

In the exercise of the general administrative and supervisory authority over the courts of Illinois conferred on this Court pursuant to Article VI, Section 16, of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 (Ill. Const. 1970, art. VI, sec. 16), and in view of the outbreak of the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19"),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Effective immediately and until further order of the Court, Illinois Supreme Court Rule 113 is temporarily amended to add a new paragraph (j) as follows (new material is underscored):

(j) Remote Appearances. All aspects of foreclosure proceedings, including but not limited to status hearings, case management hearings, entry of judgment of foreclosure, judicial sales, and entry of an order approving sale, may be conducted remotely, including by online or video/audio conference means. Each circuit court shall determine which aspects of a foreclosure proceeding may be conducted remotely based on the needs of the jurisdiction, case participants, and technology available.
