IT IS ORDERED: Emergency motion by Petitioners for expedited consideration of Petition for Leave to Appeal and any subsequent proceedings on appeal. Allowed. The petition for leave to appeal is <u>denied</u>. In the exercise of this Court's supervisory authority, the February 4, 2022, temporary restraining order is <u>vacated</u>. (See, e.g., *Felzak v. The matter is remanded to the Circuit Court of Sangamon County.
