In re: Judicial Assignment

The Supreme Court having determined that the public necessity so requires;

Effective October 3, 2022, and until further order of the Court, the Honorable Sanjay T. Tailor, Judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County, is assigned to duty in the Appellate Court of Illinois, First District, to the position currently held by the Honorable Daniel J. Pierce, who is retiring from judicial service on September 30, 2022. Judge Tailor shall occupy the current rotation position of Judge Pierce in the Sixth Division and shall be assigned the cases of Judge Pierce upon taking office.

During such service on the Appellate Court, Judge Tailor is relieved from all his regular duties in the Circuit Court of Cook County, and he shall receive compensation for such active service at the rate normally paid Appellate Judges of the State of Illinois.
