ILLINOIS SUPREME COURT BUILDINGS IN CHICAGO, SPRINGFIELD TO CLOSE DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

The Illinois Supreme Court has authorized the Illinois Courts facilities in the Michael A. Bilandic Building in Chicago, the Supreme Court Building in Springfield, and the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts offices in both Chicago and Springfield to be closed beginning Thursday, December 22, 2022 at noon and continuing on Friday, December 23, 2022.

The National Weather Service has issued alerts predicting significant and problematic snow accumulation, wind speeds causing blizzard conditions, and extremely low air temperatures and wind chills throughout Illinois beginning Thursday afternoon and continuing through Friday.

The Supreme Court Clerk will work remotely and e-filings will continue to be accepted.
