WHAT'S NEXT

NEXT STEP FOR PERSON FILLING OUT THIS FORM:

After you fill out your *Petition*, file it with the Circuit Clerk's office in the county where your case is taking place. Find your Circuit Clerk at ilcourts.info/clerks. You will need to get a court date and file a *Notice of Court Date for Petition*. Ask the Circuit Clerk if you have to schedule a court date or if one will be scheduled automatically when you file your *Petition*. In some counties, you may get the court date when you e-file. Include the court date on your *Notice*.

After you file your *Petition*, you must notify the person or business who sued you. You can do this by sending them the forms by certified mail. You could also ask the sheriff or a private process server to deliver them.
