MANDATE PENDING

Dan Caulkins et al., Appellees, v. Jay Robert Pritzker, in His Official Capacity as Governor of the State of Illinois, et al., Appellants. Appeal, Circuit Court (Macon).

Motion by Appellees to stay issuance of mandate pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 368(c) pending the filing of a petition for writ of certiorari in the United States Supreme Court. Allowed

The mandate of this Court in the above cause is stayed pending the filing of a petition for writ of certiorari or the expiration of the period within which said petition may be filed. If a petition for writ of certiorari is filed, the mandate of this Court shall, upon proof of such filing being made by affidavit filed with the clerk of this Court, be further stayed pending resolution by the United States Supreme Court of such petition. If no such affidavit is filed, the mandate shall, without further order, issue upon the expiration of the time within which certiorari may be sought.
